Principal's Desk



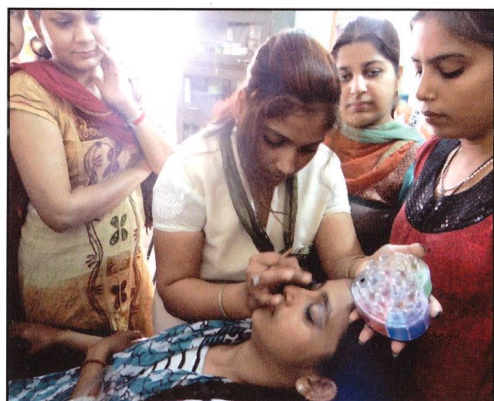

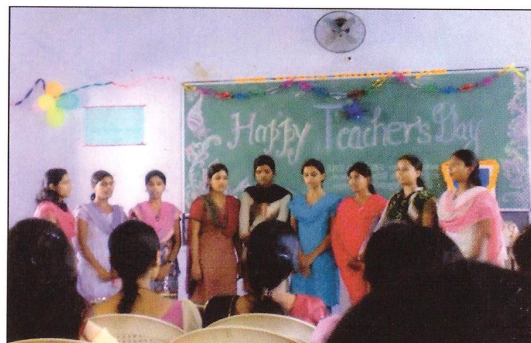
3. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) :

Teacher's Day

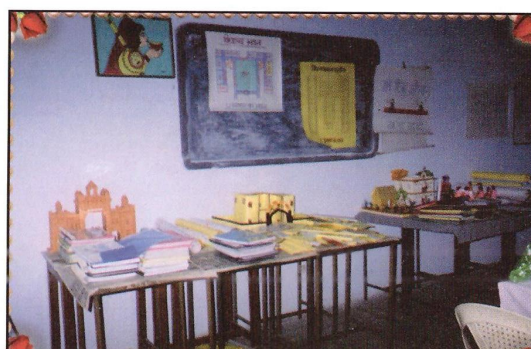

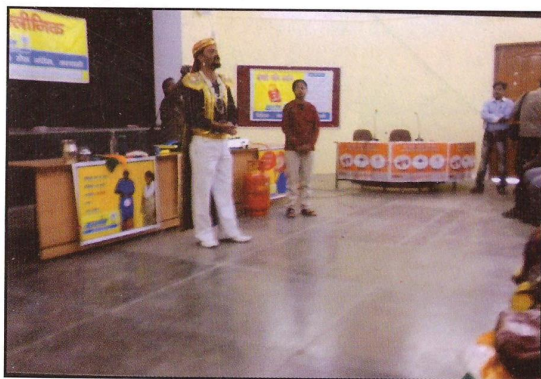
हिन्दी दिवस

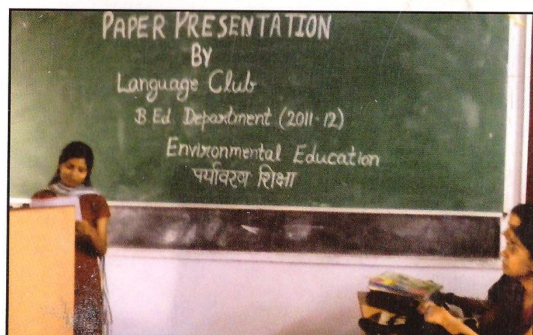

World Health Day

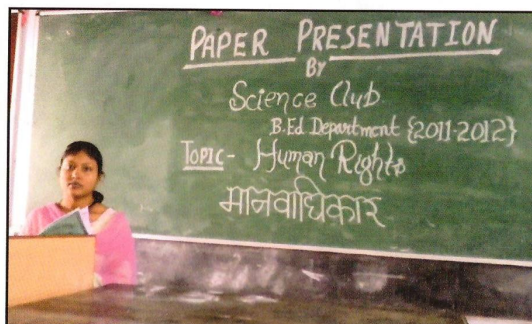

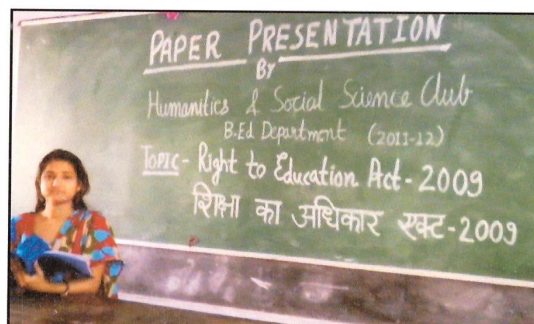
Paper Presentation by Students

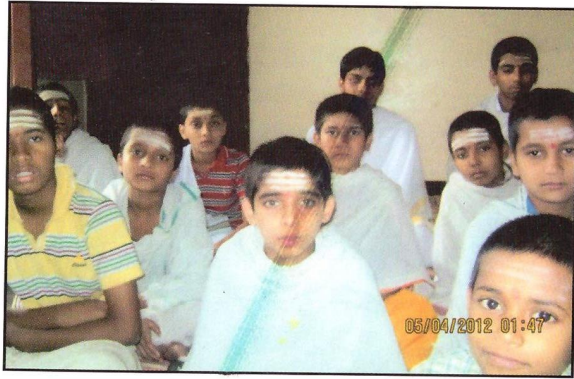
Extension Activities
