
Department of Philosophy organized an educational tour to Sarnath, Varanasi on 26th March 2017 with 24 participants.


WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY



College celebrated International Yoga Day on 21st June 2017. All the teaching and nonteaching staff with Principal and Manager participated in this event.






CENTRE FOR BUDDHIST STUDIES 7 DAY INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON VIPASSANA



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
