20. It is said, 'Think before you speak' and it can be added to that 'Read before you think'. This is true for all, more so in the case of teachers and teacher educators. It is an obvious observation today that the undergraduate students in-our universities need to be voracious readers and effective communicators through writing in order to excel in the globally competitive era. The education system today is advancing towards imparting the 21st century skills to its learners. The four Cs which are most sought after in the 21st century skills are Critical thinking, Creativity, Collaboration and Communication. If the prospective teachers passing out of the universities are to be equipped with the essential 21st century skills, reading and reflecting on what is read is the first step.

Need and importance- A number of studies have shown that the teachers as well as student teachers do not read books other than the text books they have to teach or the books related to the syllabus of the course they are pursuing. As the goal of any teacher education programme is to prepare teachers as reflective practitioners. One of the strategies to achieve this goal could be to provide opportunities to the student teachers to read the given texts and to reflection various angles. With this aim NCTE has incorporated the course "Reading, and Reflecting on Texts" for teacher education programmes since 2014 under the courses for Enhancing Professional Capacities. The course is aimed at creating an atmosphere to learn to read and think, both individually and interactively in groups; thereafter, respond critically and creatively. 
Day-3




Day 4

Topic of lecture: Reflective Reading: Principles, Process and Practice

Speaker: Dr. Arti Nirmal Date: March 16, 2023

They learned to make simple stretchers by using bed sheets/cloth and simple bamboos available in homes. They were made aware of the philosophy of first aid that a severely injured or sick person may be kept alive before the arrival of proper medical aid.

The students also learned how to prepare a tent house with sheet or fabric, bambos and ropes. This was the most interesting part of the 5-days camp. The tents were made and decorated by all the group members. They cooked food also and served it to their teachers. The camp concluded on the fifth day with a grand 'Dikshant Samaroh' where the students took a pledge to serve their country. 
3. Literary Quiz for students of MA & BA Final were organised on <u>23rd</u> of December 2023. Around 30 students participated in this event.

The Convener of the Seminar was Ms. Priya Yadav. She introduced the topic to the students remarkably and underlined the importance research holds in higher education. Further, the students of B.A IIIrd year gave presentation on various types of research methodologies, research designs, hypothesis formulation and many more. They also projected the value of research in advancement of in-depth study of social sciences. As the syllabus of B.A IIIrd year includes a paper titled 'Research Methodology in Social Sciences', the students were also benefitted from the exam point of view. 5- On 17th January, 2023, a TV program titled "Mahaul Kya Hai" sponsored by News24 was held in the premises of Arya Mahila P.G. College. The agenda of the program was to inquire about the political and social issues being discussed among the students of higher education. The program was hosted by Mr. Rajeev Ranjan. As the program aims to figure out the core reality of a situation by discussing a matter of relevance with the citizens themselves, Mr. Rajeev Ranjan briefly explained the topic for the day and moved towards the students for their point of view. The students of BA (IInd year), BA (IIIrd year) and MA (IInd year) of the Department of Political Science took active participation in the discussion. 

Mishra, the follow-up was preceded with speech of good words and welcomed by mentor Dr. Rachana Dubey (Principal, A.M.P.G.C) and formal introduction of the resource persons was delivered by Dr. Kanchan (Head of Department, Sociology).
